Examples of when to call:

- **Bats in your house?** You will be provided with advice on how best to manage these bats or remove them in a way that is safe for both people and bats.
- **Bat-related health concerns?** Your questions will be answered and you will be directed to the appropriate contacts in your area to provide you with any help necessary to protect the health of bats and people.
- **Bat sightings?** This is the number to call to report your observations!

The health of bats in Atlantic Canada is under threat from the disease bat white-nose syndrome (WNS), which continues to spread in the region and impact endangered species.
